

**Genesis 16**

**6** But Abram said to Sarai, “Behold, your maid is in your power; do to her what is good in your sight.” So Sarai treated her harshly, and she fled from her presence.

**7** Now the angel of the LORD found her by a spring of water in the wilderness, by the spring on the way to Shur.

**8** He said, “Hagar, Sarai’s maid, where have you come from and where are you going?” And she said, “I am fleeing from the presence of my mistress Sarai.”

**9** Then the angel of the LORD said to her, “Return to your mistress, and submit yourself to her authority.”

**10** Moreover, the angel of the LORD said to her, “I will greatly multiply your descendants so that they will be too many to count.”

**11** The angel of the LORD said to her further, “Behold, you are with child, And you will bear a son; And you shall call his name Ishmael, Because the LORD has given heed to your affliction.

**12** “He will be a wild donkey of a man, His hand will be against everyone, And everyone’s hand will be against him; And he will live to the east of all his brothers.”

**13** Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, “You are a God who sees”; for she said, “Have I even remained alive here after seeing Him?”

**Genesis 22**

**10** Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son.

**11** But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, “Abraham, Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.”

**12** He said, “Do not stretch out your hand against the lad, and do nothing to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me.”

**13** Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son.

**14** Abraham called the name of that place The LORD Will Provide, as it is said to this day, “In the mount of the LORD it will be provided.”

**15** Then the angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time from heaven,

**16** and said, “By Myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son,

**17** indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies.

**18** “In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”

**Genesis 28**

**10** Then Jacob departed from Beersheba and went toward Haran.

**11** He came to a certain place and spent the night there, because the sun had set; and he took one of the stones of the place and put it under his head, and lay down in that place.

**12** He had a dream, and behold, a ladder was set on the earth with its top reaching to heaven; and behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.

**Genesis 28 (cont.)**

**13** And behold, the LORD stood above it and said, “I am the LORD, the God of your father Abraham and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie, I will give it to you and to your descendants.

**14** “Your descendants will also be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south; and in you and in your descendants shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

**15** “Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you.”

**16** Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, “Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it.”

**17** He was afraid and said, “How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven.”

**18** So Jacob rose early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put under his head and set it up as a pillar and poured oil on its top.

**19** He called the name of that place Bethel; however, previously the name of the city had been Luz.

**20** Then Jacob made a vow, saying, “If God will be with me and will keep me on this journey that I take, and will give me food to eat and garments to wear,

**21** and I return to my father’s house in safety, then the LORD will be my God.

**22** “This stone, which I have set up as a pillar, will be God’s house, and of all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You.”

**Genesis 31**

**11** “Then the angel of God said to me in the dream, ‘Jacob,’ and I said, ‘Here I am.’

**12** “He said, ‘Lift up now your eyes and see that all the male goats which are mating are striped, speckled, and mottled; for I have seen all that Laban has been doing to you.

**13** ‘I am the God of Bethel, where you anointed a pillar, where you made a vow to Me; now arise, leave this land, and return to the land of your birth.’”

**Genesis 32**

**24** Then Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him until daybreak.

**25** When he saw that he had not prevailed against him, he touched the socket of his thigh; so the socket of Jacob’s thigh was dislocated while he wrestled with him.

**26** Then he said, “Let me go, for the dawn is breaking.” But he said, “I will not let you go unless you bless me.”

**27** So he said to him, “What is your name?” And he said, “Jacob.”

**28** He said, “Your name shall no longer be Jacob, but Israel; for you have striven with God and with men and have prevailed.”

**29** Then Jacob asked him and said, “Please tell me your name.” But he said, “Why is it that you ask my name?” And he blessed him there.

**30** So Jacob named the place Peniel, for he said, “I have seen God face to face, yet my life has been preserved.”

### **Hosea 12**

**3** In the womb he took his brother by the heel, And in his maturity he contended with God.

**4** Yes, he wrestled with the angel and prevailed; He wept and sought His favor. He found Him at Bethel And there He spoke with us,

**5** Even the LORD, the God of hosts, The LORD is His name.

### **Genesis 48**

**15** He blessed Joseph, and said, “The God before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, The God who has been my shepherd all my life to this day,

**16** The angel who has redeemed me from all evil, Bless the lads; And may my name live on in them, And the names of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; And may they grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.”

### **Exodus 3**

**1** Now Moses was pasturing the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian; and he led the flock to the west side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God.

**2** The angel of the LORD appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush; and he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, yet the bush was not consumed.

**3** So Moses said, “I must turn aside now and see this marvelous sight, why the bush is not burned up.”

**4** When the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, “Moses, Moses!” And he said, “Here I am.”

**5** Then He said, “Do not come near here; remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground.”

**6** He said also, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.” Then Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.

**7** The LORD said, “I have surely seen the affliction of My people who are in Egypt, and have given heed to their cry because of their taskmasters, for I am aware of their sufferings.

### **Joshua 5**

**13** Now it came about when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, a man was standing opposite him with his sword drawn in his hand, and Joshua went to him and said to him, “Are you for us or for our adversaries?”

**14** He said, “No; rather I indeed come now as captain of the host of the LORD.” And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and bowed down, and said to him, “What has my lord to say to his servant?”

**15** The captain of the LORD’S host said to Joshua, “Remove your sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy.” And Joshua did so.

### **Judges 6**

**11** Then the angel of the LORD came and sat under the oak that was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite as his son Gideon was beating out wheat in the wine press in order to save it from the Midianites.

**12** The angel of the LORD appeared to him and said to him, “The LORD is with you, O valiant warrior.”

**Judges 6 (cont.)**

**13** Then Gideon said to him, “O my lord, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all His miracles which our fathers told us about, saying, ‘Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt?’ But now the LORD has abandoned us and given us into the hand of Midian.”

**14** The LORD looked at him and said, “Go in this your strength and deliver Israel from the hand of Midian. Have I not sent you?”

**15** He said to Him, “O Lord, how shall I deliver Israel? Behold, my family is the least in Manasseh, and I am the youngest in my father’s house.”

**16** But the LORD said to him, “Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat Midian as one man.”

**17** So Gideon said to Him, “If now I have found favor in Your sight, then show me a sign that it is You who speak with me.

**18** “Please do not depart from here, until I come back to You, and bring out my offering and lay it before You.” And He said, “I will remain until you return.”

**19** Then Gideon went in and prepared a young goat and unleavened bread from an ephah of flour; he put the meat in a basket and the broth in a pot, and brought them out to him under the oak and presented them.

**20** The angel of God said to him, “Take the meat and the unleavened bread and lay them on this rock, and pour out the broth.” And he did so.

**21** Then the angel of the LORD put out the end of the staff that was in his hand and touched the meat and the unleavened bread; and fire sprang up from the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened bread. Then the angel of the LORD vanished from his sight.

**22** When Gideon saw that he was the angel of the LORD, he said, “Alas, O Lord GOD! For now I have seen the angel of the LORD face to face.”

**23** The LORD said to him, “Peace to you, do not fear; you shall not die.”

**24** Then Gideon built an altar there to the LORD and named it The LORD is Peace. To this day it is still in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

**Judges 13**

**2** There was a certain man of Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren and had borne no children.

**3** Then the angel of the LORD appeared to the woman and said to her, “Behold now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and give birth to a son.

**4** “Now therefore, be careful not to drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing.

**5** “For behold, you shall conceive and give birth to a son, and no razor shall come upon his head, for the boy shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel from the hands of the Philistines.”

**6** Then the woman came and told her husband, saying, “A man of God came to me and his appearance was like the appearance of the angel of God, very awesome. And I did not ask him where he came from, nor did he tell me his name.

**7** “But he said to me, ‘Behold, you shall conceive and give birth to a son, and now you shall not drink wine or strong drink nor eat any unclean thing, for the boy shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb to the day of his death.’”

**8** Then Manoah entreated the LORD and said, “O Lord, please let the man of God whom You have sent come to us again that he may teach us what to do for the boy who is to be born.”

**Judges 13 (cont.)**

**9** God listened to the voice of Manoah; and the angel of God came again to the woman as she was sitting in the field, but Manoah her husband was not with her.

**10** So the woman ran quickly and told her husband, “Behold, the man who came the other day has appeared to me.”

**11** Then Manoah arose and followed his wife, and when he came to the man he said to him, “Are you the man who spoke to the woman?” And he said, “I am.”

**12** Manoah said, “Now when your words come to pass, what shall be the boy’s mode of life and his vocation?”

**13** So the angel of the LORD said to Manoah, “Let the woman pay attention to all that I said.

**14** “She should not eat anything that comes from the vine nor drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing; let her observe all that I commanded.”

**15** Then Manoah said to the angel of the LORD, “Please let us detain you so that we may prepare a young goat for you.”

**16** The angel of the LORD said to Manoah, “Though you detain me, I will not eat your food, but if you prepare a burnt offering, then offer it to the LORD.” For Manoah did not know that he was the angel of the LORD.

**17** Manoah said to the angel of the LORD, “What is your name, so that when your words come to pass, we may honor you?”

**18** But the angel of the LORD said to him, “Why do you ask my name, seeing it is wonderful?”

**19** So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering and offered it on the rock to the LORD, and He performed wonders while Manoah and his wife looked on.

**20** For it came about when the flame went up from the altar toward heaven, that the angel of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar. When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell on their faces to the ground.

**Isaiah 9:6** For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

**Gen 32:29** Then Jacob asked him and said, “Please tell me your name.” But he said, “Why is it that you ask my name?” And he blessed him there.

### **Exodus 33**

**21** Then the LORD said, "Behold, there is a place by Me, and you shall stand there on the rock;

**22** and it will come about, while My glory is passing by, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock and cover you with My hand until I have passed by.

**23** "Then I will take My hand away and you shall see My back, but My face shall not be seen."
