### How does spiritually justifying wrong affect us?

- It may cover up our true motives.
- It removes the fault from us, and places it on the Lord.
- It makes us call evil good, or wrong right.
- It shows we do not have an accurate understanding of the Lord: His nature and character, His principles

## How do we avoid doing this?

- Know God. Know His Word
- Examine your motives before God
- Entrust yourself to Him who judges righteously (1 Pet. 2:23)
- Do not seek your own justice
- Seek godly counsel and heed it
- Confess and repent (I John 1:9)

#### Psalm 23

Therefore, I exhort the elders among you, as your fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed, 2 shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to the will of God; and not for sordid gain, but with eagerness; 3 nor yet as lording it over those allotted to your charge, but proving to be examples to the flock




How did the leaders of Israel come under condemnation from the Lord for how they handled their responsibilities in shepherding His people? (Ezekiel 34)






# 2 Samuel 5:10, 12
