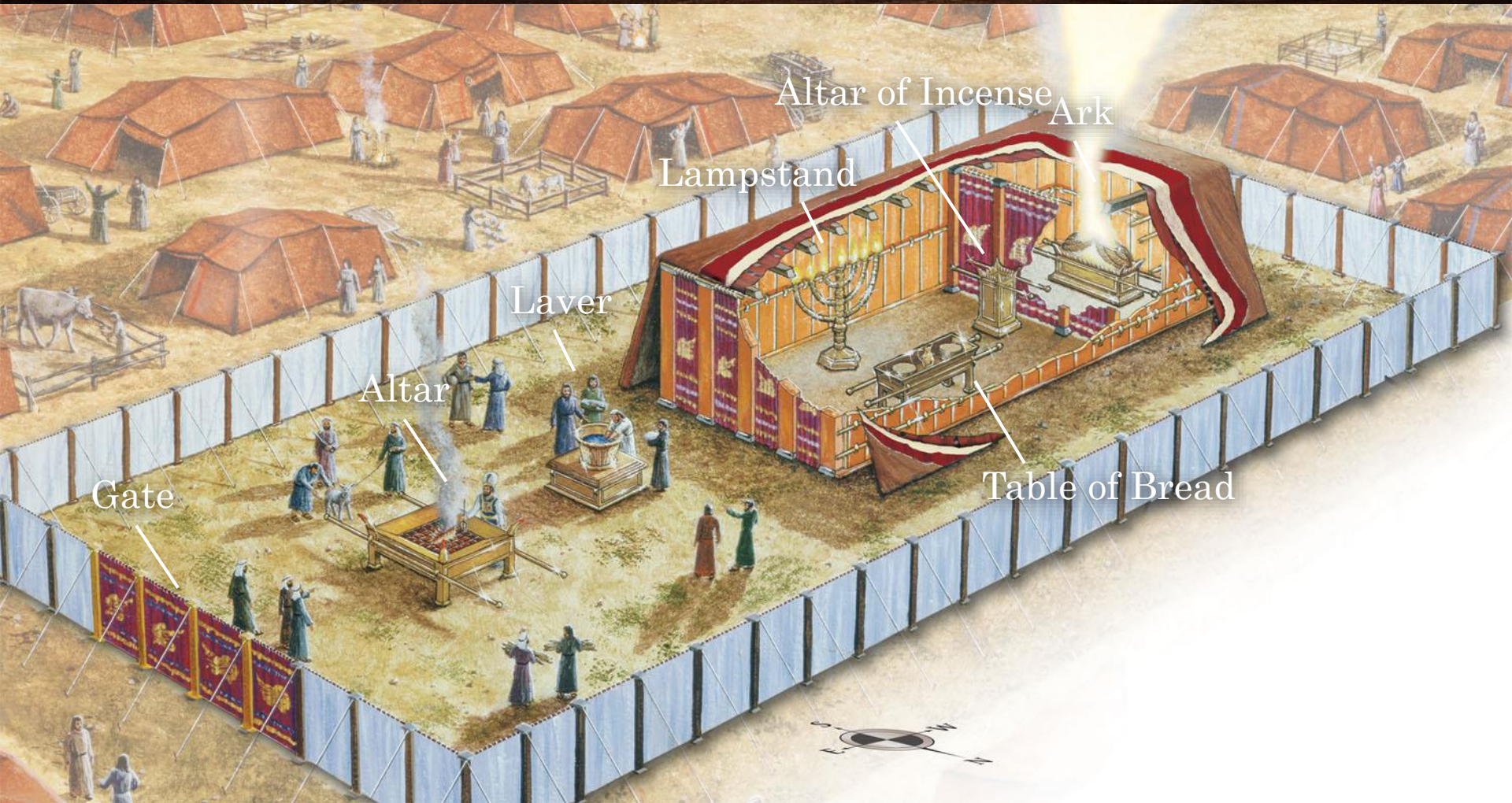

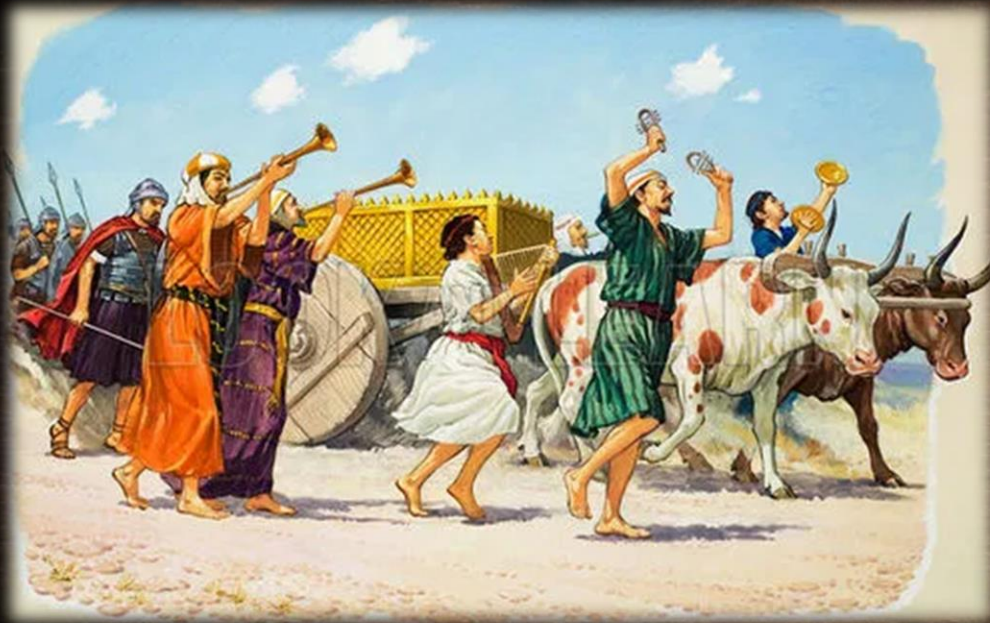

# Why did God kill Uzzah?

1. He was irreverent to touch the ark (v. 7).
2. Even the sons of Kohath, whose job was to carry the ark, never looked at it or touched it lest they die (Num. 4:15-20).
3. Uzzah would not have needed to steady the ark if they had been carrying it God's way (1 Chr. 15:13).
4. God seems to be especially sensitive about His holiness at key transitions.

# Compare Uzzah's Death To

1. The deaths of Nadab & Abihu, sons of Aaron, who died for offering strange fire at the beginning of Tabernacle worship
2. The deaths of Achan & his family, who died for stealing from God, lying about it, & causing the deaths of soldiers in battle
3. The deaths of Ananias & Sapphira, who died for lying to the Holy Spirit (in early days of the establishment of the church)

# GOD SAID

# What Did David Learn?

## 1. He regained his FEAR of God.

- The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom (Prov. 9:10).
- The fear of God is the beginning of knowledge (Prov. 1:7).
- The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever (Ps. 19:9).
- Fear God (1 Pet 2:17).

# What Did David Learn?

2. He learned more about the HOLINESS of God—the characteristic of God that defines Him more than any other.

**Ex 28:40** For Aaron's sons you shall make **tunics**, and you shall make **sashes** for them. And you shall make **hats** for them, for glory and beauty.

# What David Wore

1 Chronicles 15:27

David was clothed with a **robe** of fine linen, as were all the Levites who bore the ark, the singers, and Chenaniah the music master with the singers. **David also wore a linen ephod.**

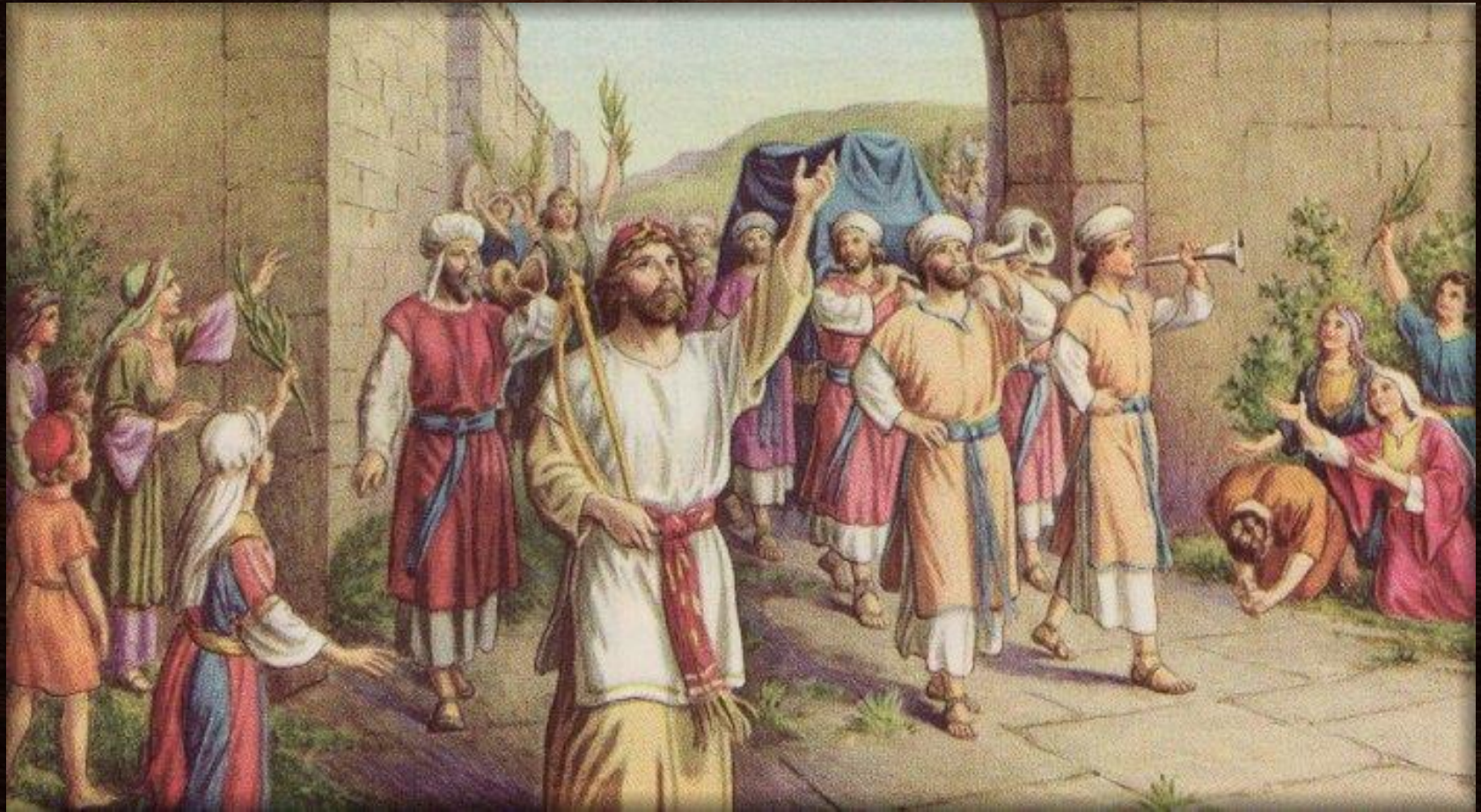

# Lessons from 2 Samuel 6

1. God is holy—completely separate from sin—the most basic characteristic of God!
2. We need to communicate His holiness to others.
  - Don't skip the hard parts of the Bible.
  - Don't be surprised when God does what He promised to do.
  - Model respect & fear for God.
  - Emphasize how far above us He is.

# Lessons from 2 Samuel 6

3. When we come to God, we come on His terms, not ours.
  - Uzzah had good intentions, but He was disobeying & dishonoring God.
  - Nothing we can DO will make us acceptable to God (Eph. 2:8-9; John 6:28-29; John 14:6; Acts 4:12).
  - Seeing Who He is should humble us, help us see our sinfulness & repent (1 Jn. 1:8-9).
