





Date Written?


- Unknown

- No reference to fall of Jerusalem in 70 A.D.






Purpose?

OUTLINE OF HEBREWS

- Introduction: God has spoken to us in His Son (1:1-4).
- Jesus is superior to the angels (1:5–2:18).
- Jesus is superior to Moses (3:1–4:13).
- Jesus is superior to the OT priests (4:14–7:28).



OUTLINE OF HEBREWS

- Jesus gives a superior covenant with superior promises (8:1–10:34).
- Jesus gives a superior way to please God—by faith (10:35–12:29).
- Writer closes with reminders and greetings (13:1-25).
