



## JESUS, GOD'S SON


- Embodied God's Word (1:2)

Perfect King (enthroned)




“But from now on THE SON OF MAN WILL BE SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND of the power OF GOD.” And they all said, “Are You the Son of God, then?” And He said to them, “Yes, I am” (Luke 22:69-70).



And we preach to you the good news of the promise made to the fathers, that God has fulfilled this promise to our children in that He raised up Jesus, as it is also written in the second Psalm, ‘YOU ARE MY SON; TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU’ (Acts 13:32-33).

## Firstborn (1:6)

- Firstborn in status, not time
- A Messianic title (Ps. 89:27)
- Does not mean that God had more than one Son
- Does not mean Jesus didn't exist before Bethlehem.
