


Ch 1: Jesus, better than the angels; He is God the Son.








Description of the OT high priest:
Taken from among men; Heb 5:1
Appointed; called by God; v.1
From the line of Aaron, tribe of Levi; v.4
He offers sacrifices for the sins of the people and his own sins; v.3
Was to "deal gently with the ignorant and misguided;" v.2

"The LORD then *spoke to Aaron*, saying, 'Do not drink wine or strong drink, neither you nor *your sons*...so as *to make a distinction between the holy and the profane*, and between the unclean and the clean, and so as *to teach the sons of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken* to them through Moses."" Lev 10:8-11

"Her *priests* have done violence to My law and have profaned My holy things; they *have made no distinction between the holy and the profane*, and they *have not taught the difference between the unclean and the clean*; and they hide their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them." Ezek 22:26

## Melchizedek:

- Only mentioned in 3 passages in the Bible: Gen 14:18-24; Ps 110:4; Heb 5:6-11; 6:20-7:28.
- He pre-dates the Aaronic priesthood.
- He was the King of Salem (Jerusalem) & priest of the Most High God.
- · Jesus is from the tribe of Judah, qualified to
- rule on the throne of David; He is a Priest after the order of Melchizedek = King AND Priest!
