- a. sound wisdom, substance (v.7)
- b. shield & buckler (v.7)
- c. God guards & preserves (v.8)
- d. understanding of righteousness & justice (v.9)

- b. The way of the righteous
 1. the path of justice, the way of His godly ones (v.8)
 2. every good course (v.9)
 3. the paths of uprightness (v.13)
 4. the paths of life (v.19)
 5. the way of good men (v.20)

 1. the way of evil (v.12)
 2. the ways of darkness (v.13)
 3. crooked paths, devious ways (v.15)
