To Sons: Avoid Immoral Women

- Two types:
 - The prostitute
 - The unfaithful wife
- Called “strange” or “foreign”
 - They act outside the bounds of God’s law and social convention.

Immorality—Commonplace—Why?

- No Fear of God
- Living to please self
- Media presents it as the norm
- Breakdown of families
- Contraceptives / Abortion—
eliminating disruption to lifestyle of
pregnancy

Ways a Woman Traps a Man



- Flattery (sweet, smooth words)
- Enticing appearance
- Aggressive pursuit / Availability
- Staying in contact in person & via messages
- Describing what they could do
- Implying they will face no consequences

How do I speak to my husband?

- Do I criticize him or build him up?
- Do I ask him about his day and really listen to him?
- Do I do and say things to make him feel special?
- Does he know that I respect and love him?

Who falls into the sin of adultery?

- The overconfident fool
(1 Cor. 10:12)
- The naïve fool (Prov.7:7, 22, 23)
- The mocker of God's standards
(Prov. 5:11-14)



Guard your thoughts.

- For as he thinks in his heart, so is he (Proverbs 23:7).
- Watch over your heart with all diligence, For from it flow the springs of life (Proverbs 4:23).

Guard your thoughts.

- “I made a covenant with my eyes not to look with lust at a young woman” (Job 31:1, NLT).
- Do not desire her beauty in your heart, Nor let her capture you with her eyelids (Proverbs 6:25).

HOW TO

BEDROOM EYES

- 1 APPLY DARK MATTE SHADOW TO MID-LID AND WING OUT
- 2 CONTINUE WITH LINER FROM INNER CORNER, ALONG LOWER WATER LINE
- 3 LOOK WHO'S SMOLDERING



Hope for Sinners

- Believe God's promise to forgive when you confess (1 John 1:9).
- Focus on God's forgiveness that has cleansed you and removed you from that sinful lifestyle (1 Cor. 6:11).

Hope for Sinners

- Know that God will restore the joy of His salvation and permit you to serve Him (Ps. 51:12-13).
- By God's grace and in His strength, forsake this sin from now on (John 8:11; Php.2:13).

How do I apply this lesson?

- Be aware of how my words, actions, appearance could mislead or tempt a man. Be considerate.
- Be intentional about having the right kind of relationship with my husband.
- Avoid men who would try to seduce me.
