PSALM 119

The Power of God's Word

ROMANS 15:4

For whatever was written
in earlier times
was written for our instruction,
so that through perseverance
and the encouragement
of the Scriptures
we might have hope.

GOD'S WORD

- The Law (*Torah*): Instruction, <u>teaching</u>;
 especially "The Law" as a whole (119:1)
- Testimony (Ed, Edah): Always used in reference to the <u>testimony of God</u>. Usually connected with the Tabernacle. Sometimes stands alone to refer to the ark of God. <u>Warning</u>, admonition, especially of the 10 Commandments, <u>divine legislation</u>; to say again and again or affirm (119:2)

GOD'S WORD

- Way (*Derek*): a road; figuratively, <u>a course</u>
 of life or mode of action (119:3)
- Precepts (*Piqqudim*): Always used in the plural; <u>responsibilities</u> God places on people. Used only in Psalms (119:4)
- Statute (Choq): Something decreed, prescribed; usually <u>positive</u> statutes or tasks; institutions of religious and civil polity. Used also of privileges and duties (119:5, 8)

GOD'S WORD

- Commandment (*Mitzvah*): A command,
 especially of God; often contains the idea of something that is <u>prohibited</u> (119:6, 10)
- Ordinance (*Mishpat*): Something to which <u>penalties</u> were attached; divine judgment, right, privilege, verdict, regulation; rule, just decrees, sometimes translated *judgment* (119:7)

GOD'S WORD

- Word (*Dabar*): Word, saying, talking; used especially of <u>The Ten Commandments</u> because they were literally spoken out loud by God (119:9)
- Word (*Imra; Emrah*): <u>utterance</u>, answer, speech, word, saying, promise (119:11)

PSALM 119:122

- Be surety for Your servant for good;
 Do not let the arrogant oppress me (NASB).
- Guarantee your servant's well-being;
 do not let the arrogant oppress me
 (CSB).

DELIGHT IN GOD'S WORD

- I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies,
 As much as in all riches (Ps. 119:14; cf. v.72).
- I shall delight in Your statutes; I shall not forget Your word (Ps. 119:16).

AWE FOR GOD'S WORD

- Princes persecute me without cause,
 But my heart stands in awe of Your words (Ps. 119:161).
- My flesh trembles for fear of You, And I am afraid of Your judgments (Ps. 119:120).

LOVE FOR GOD & HIS WORD

- Turn to me and be gracious to me, After Your manner with those who love Your name (Ps. 119:132).
- How blessed are those who observe His testimonies,
 Who seek Him with all their heart (Ps. 119:2).

GOD'S WORD IS

- righteous (7, 75, 123, 138, 144, 172)
- dependable (86, 142, 151,160)
- forever (89-90, 152)

GOD'S WORD GIVES

- Wisdom (19:8; 119:98)
- Joy (19:8)
- Understanding (19:8; 119:100, 130)
- Warning (19:11)
- Counsel (119:28)
- Strength (119:28)

ACROSTIC

- In English, a short poem or saying in which the first letters of the lines form a word, a name, or a sentence
- God's
- Righteousness

GOD'S WORD GIVES

- Reverence for God (119:38)
- Life (119:50, 93)
- Liberty (119:45)
- Comfort (119:50, 92)
- Guidance (119:130)
- Peace (119:165)

ACROSTIC

- In Hebrew, poetic sections of Scripture in which every verse begins with the same letter of the Hebrew alphabet.
- In Psalm 119, all 22 letters appear in order.
 In each 8-verse section, every verse begins with the same Hebrew letter.
- Other acrostic passages: Psalms 25, 34,
 37, 111, 112, 145; Prov. 31:10-31; Lam.1-4

HEBREW ALPHABET—22 LETTERS Read right to left. Some have 2 forms.



SURPRISING LAST VERSE

I have gone astray
like a lost sheep;
seek Your servant,
For I do not forget
Your commandments.
Psalm 119:176

WHEN DID HE GO ASTRAY?

- Before I was afflicted I went astray,
 But now I keep Your word (Ps. 119:67).
- The wicked have laid a snare for me, Yet I have not gone astray from Your precepts (Ps. 119:110).

WHY END THIS WAY?

- He's aware of his sinfulness and of the fact that he can still go astray.
- He's begging God to seek him in such a case.
- He's still God's servant.
- He's also pledging not to forget God's commandments.

Isaíah 53:6

All of us like sheep have gone astray,

Each of us has turned

to his own way;

But the LORD has caused

the iniquity of us all

To fall on Him.

Jesus saíd:
