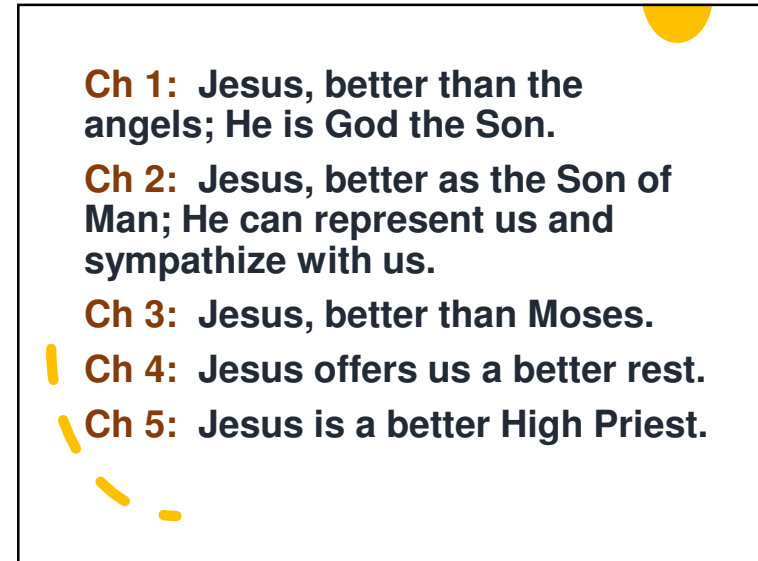
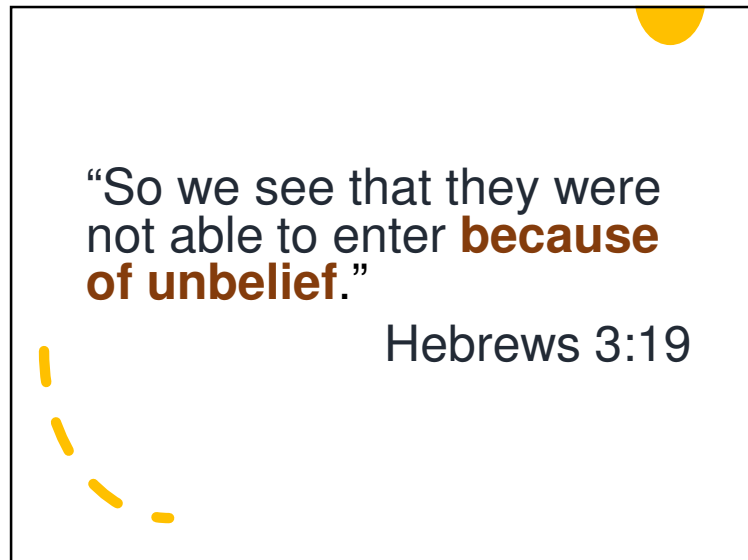


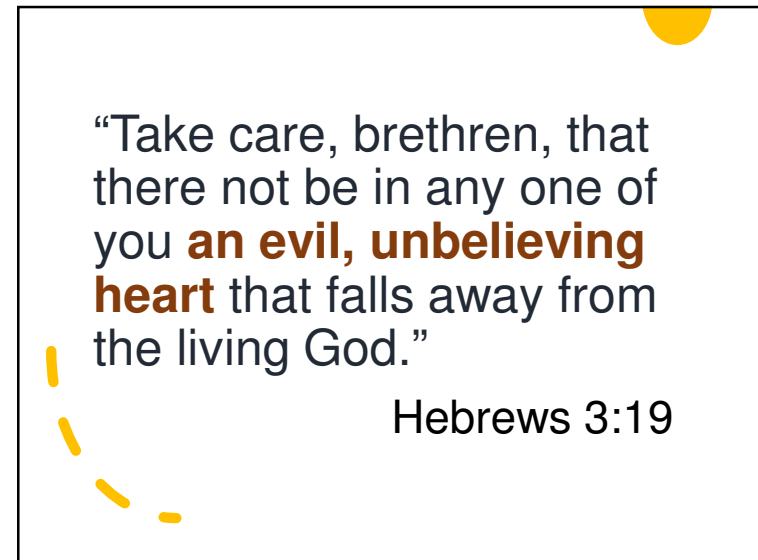

Description of the OT high priest:

- Taken from among men; Heb 5:1
- Appointed; called by God; v.1
- From the line of Aaron, tribe of Levi; v.4
- He offers sacrifices for the sins of the people and his own sins; v.3
- Was to “deal gently with the ignorant and misguided;” v.2

“The LORD then **spoke to Aaron**, saying, ‘Do not drink wine or strong drink, neither you nor **your sons**...so as **to make a distinction between the holy and the profane**, and between the unclean and the clean, and so as **to teach the sons of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken** to them through Moses.”

“Her **priests** have done violence to My law and have profaned My holy things; they *have made no distinction between the holy and the profane*, and they **have not taught the difference between the unclean and the clean**; and they hide their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.”

Christ is a better high priest:

- Appointed by God; v.5
- Is a Priest forever; v.6
- After the order of Melchizedek; v.6,10
- Took on flesh; v.7
- Able to sympathize with human suffering; v.8

Heb 5:11 “Concerning him [Melchizedek] we have much to say, and it is hard to explain...”

“...**since you have become dull of hearing.**”

Melchizedek:

- Only mentioned in 3 passages in the Bible: Gen 14:18-24; Ps 110:4; Heb 5:6-11; 6:20-7:28.
- He pre-dates the Aaronic priesthood.
- He was the King of Salem (Jerusalem) & priest of the Most High God.
- Jesus is from the tribe of Judah, qualified to rule on the throne of David; He is a Priest after the order of Melchizedek = King AND Priest!

Lessons from Hebrews 4-5:

1. Keep your hearts tender to God's Word. Heed the warnings against a hard heart.
2. Emphasis on "today;" respond to Him today! (Gen 6:3)
3. The Lord wants us to draw near to Him.
