


## The Law has a shadow.

## Hebrews 5:12

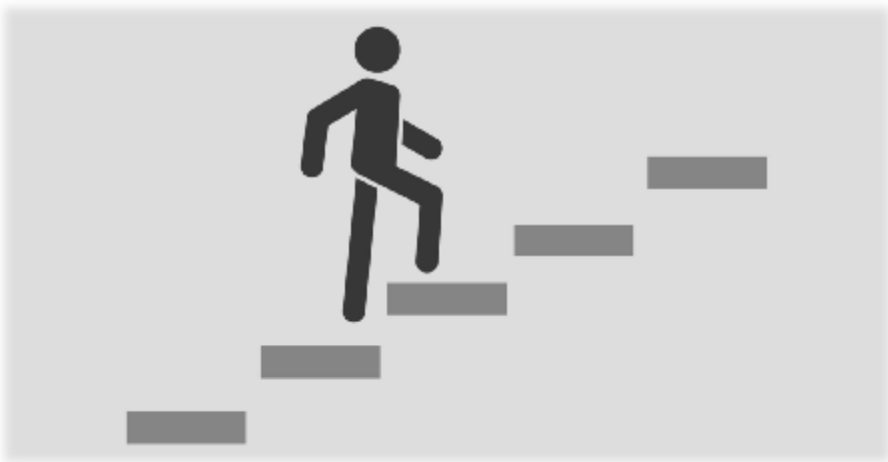
For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food.




Therefore leaving

on to maturity (6:1a).




## Old Covenant Sacrifices

- 
- Had to be repeated (1)
  - Reminded people of sins (3)
  - Could never take away sins (4)
  - Didn't ultimately please God (5)
  - Abolished by Christ's sacrifice as He came to do the Father's will (9)




So Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him (Heb 9:28).


## THE CONTRAST (10:11-12)

- 
- § Standing vs. Sitting
  - § Many vs. One Sacrifice
  - § Time after Time vs. Once for All
  
  - § Jesus sits because His work of redemption is done. His sacrifice never needs to be repeated. (Cf. 1.3; 8.1; 12.2.)


## SANCTIFY = SET APART

- 
- You shall anoint the laver . . . and sanctify it (Ex 40:11).
  - Set bounds around [Mt Sinai] and sanctify it (Ex 19:23).
  - Let the priests . . . sanctify themselves (Ex 19:22).


## SANCTIFY = SET APART

- 
- Sanctify unto Me all the first-born (Ex 13:2).
  - The Lord Jesus sanctified Himself: “For their sakes I sanctify Myself” (Jn 17:19).

## SANCTIFY = SET APART



For the unbelieving husband is sanctified through his wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified through her believing husband; for otherwise your children are unclean, but now they are holy [sanctified, **set apart**] (1 Cor 7:14).



1 John 5:3 says, “For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome.”

## We are to



- v.22—Draw near to God.
- v.23—Hold fast the confession of our hope.
- v.24—Consider one another to provoke love & good works (not failing to assemble).

## Hebrews 10:29



- Denying Jesus’ deity, like crucifying Him anew
- Treating His blood as if it meant nothing when it means everything
- Rejecting the very power that allows one to have faith and believe.




## 1 John 2:19

They went out from us, but they did not really belong to us. For if they had belonged to us, they would have remained with us; but their going showed that none of them belonged to us.



## The Need for Endurance

- You have been faithful in the past, even in times of persecution (32-34).
- v.35—Don't throw away your confidence!
- v.36—Endure.
- v.37—Be patient—Jesus WILL return.
- v.38—Live by faith.



As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, but like the Holy One who called you, be holy [set apart] yourselves also in all your behavior

(1Peter 1:14-15).
