"Ephraim feeds on wind" (12:1)

- Baal (meaning Lord or Master) is the same as Yahweh.
- My prosperity shows that I'm doing right. God is blessing me!
- Baal is the source of my blessings.
- l'm not a sinner.
- I must seek help from foreign nations (Assyria and Egypt).

Esau and Jacob (Gen. 25:25-26)

- Esau reflects a play on the word for "hairy."
- Edom—Esau's other name—means "red."
- Jacob—"at the heel"—came to mean "supplanter."

Jacob—Major Life Events

- Gen. 27:6-46—Jacob steals the blessing of the firstborn and leaves for the home of Laban, his uncle.
- Gen. 28:10-22—Jacob's dream of the stairway to heaven; God's covenant with Abraham & Isaac extended to Jacob (blessings of land, innumerable descendants, a Descendant Who would bless all nations of the earth).

Gen. 28:18-22—Jacob names the place, *Bethel* (*house of God*). He vows to serve God.





Jacob—Major Life Events

- Gen. 31 & 32—Twenty years later, Jacob leaves Laban's household and starts on his journey home with his wives, children, and herds.
- Gen. 32:24-30—Jacob wrestles with God, gets his name changed to *Israel (he who strives with God)*, & names the place *Peniel (face of God)*.



Fear the Lord (Hosea 13:7-8)

Prov. 9:10—The <u>fear of the LORD</u> is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
