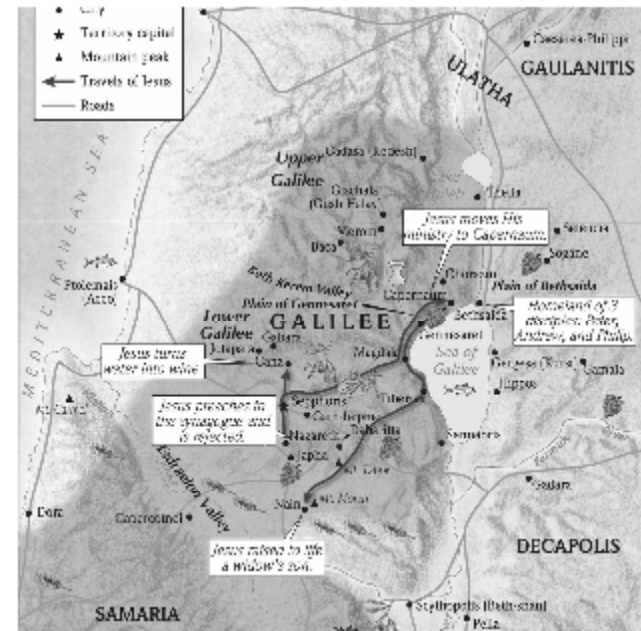
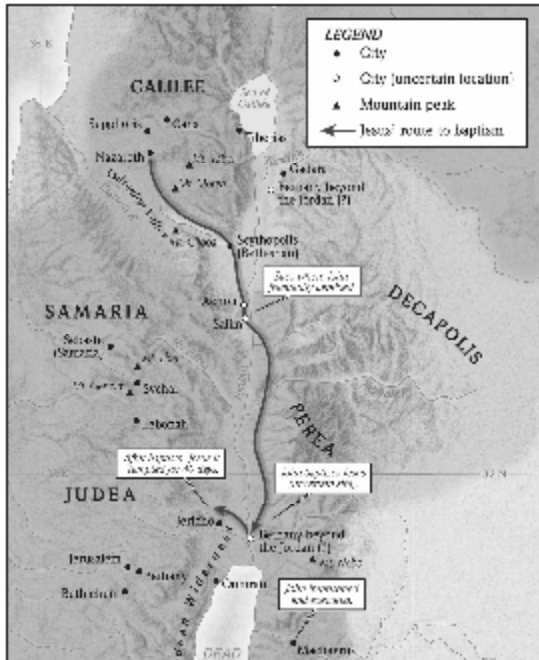

Day 1	1:19-28	John the Baptist's reply to the priests & Levites: "I'm a voice."
Day 2	1:29-34	John the Baptist's declaration: "Behold the Lamb of God!" "This is the Son of God."
Day 3	1:35-42	John the Baptist's repeated declaration leading to three followers of Jesus: Andrew, Peter, and an unnamed man (John?)
Day 4	1:43-51	Jesus' call of Philip & Philip's recruitment of Nathanael
Day 7	2:1-11	Jesus' first miracle at the wedding in Cana

Lamb of God

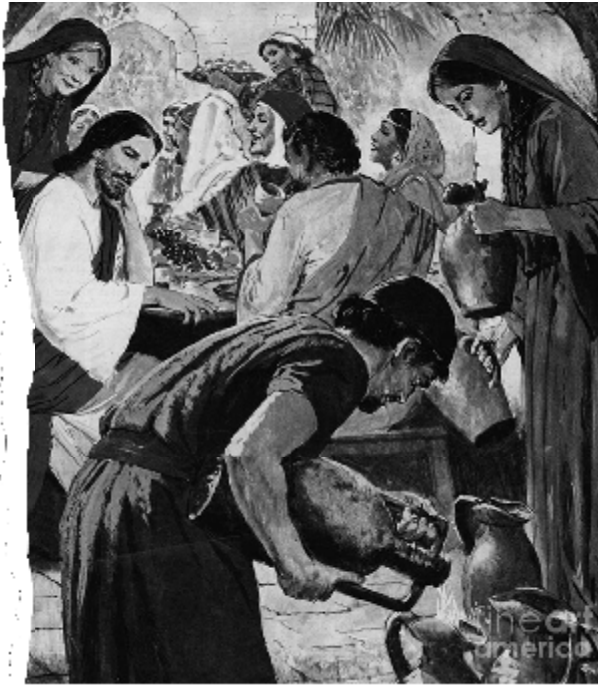
1. Exodus 12—Passover
2. Isaiah 53—Messiah said to be "like a lamb that is led to slaughter, and like a sheep that is silent before its shearers" (7); "a Man of sorrows & acquainted with grief" (3). He "bore . . . our griefs, and carried our sorrows" (4); "He was wounded for our transgressions" (5).
3. Lambs were offered daily as sacrifices in the Temple (Exodus 29:38).

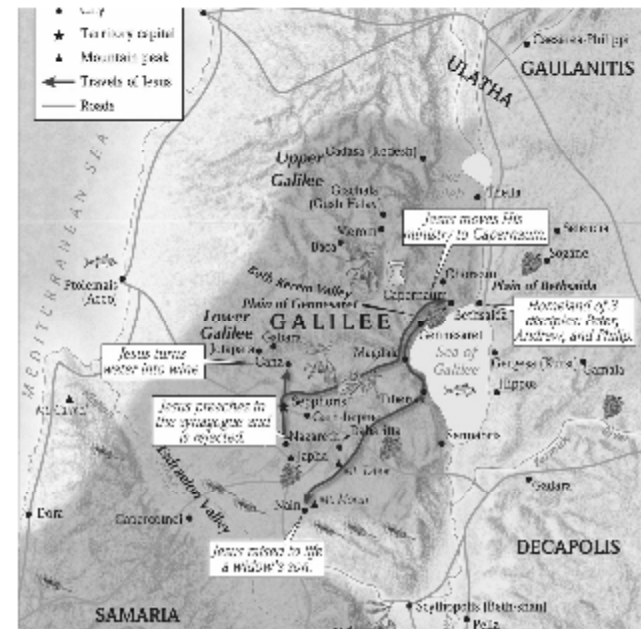

Drinking Wine

- Rom. 14:21—Don't drink wine if it causes your brother to stumble.
- Eph. 5:18—Don't be drunk with wine, but be filled with the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Tim. 3:8—Deacons must not be given to much wine.
- Titus 2:3—Older women are not to be enslaved to wine.

2. His attributes of deity
 - omniscience—all knowing (1:47-48;
2:24-25)
 - omnipotence—all powerful (1:9;
2:23)

THINGS WE LEARN ABOUT JESUS IN JOHN 1:35-2:25

3. His nature
 - graciousness to disciples (1:39)
 - approval of marriage (2:1-11)
 - kindness to a bridegroom (2:3-10)
 - anger, zeal for His Father's house
(2:15-17)

THINGS WE LEARN ABOUT THE DISCIPLES

They

- were seeking God & willing to act.
- passed on the good news to others.
- knew the Scriptures (1:41, 45, 46, 49; 2:17).
- believed the Scripture (Ps. 16:10).

Final Challenge:
