


JESUS FACES ROMAN SOLDIERS



JUDAS' BETRAYAL

- Matthew 26:14-16—Judas takes 30 pieces of silver to hand Jesus over to the soldiers.
- Matthew 26:48-49—Judas kisses Jesus to acknowledge He is the One to arrest.
- John 13:26-27, 30—Jesus gives Judas the bread to identify him as His betrayer, and Satan enters him.

JESUS DECLARES "I AM"



John 8:58—Before Abraham was born, I AM! Exodus 3:14—I AM WHO I AM

SOLDIERS FALL TO THE GROUND



- Jesus was born as a humble baby, yet announced by angels.
- Jesus was laid in a manger, yet signaled by a star.
- Jesus submitted to baptism as if He were a sinner, then heard the Divine voice of approval.
- Jesus slept when He was exhausted, but awoke to calm the storm.

- Jesus wept at a grave, then called the dead to life (Lazarus).
- Jesus surrendered to arrest, then declared "I am" and knocked all the troops over.
- Jesus died on a cross, but in it He defeated sin, death, and Satan.

PETER CUTS OFF SERVANT'S EAR

- Matthew 26:35—Peter declared, "Even if I have to die with you, I will never disown you."
- Luke 22:51—But Jesus answered, "No more of this!" And he touched the man's ear and healed him.

JESUS' ARREST

- Jesus surrendered Himself
- He complied with His Father's will

John 10:17-18

 The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life—only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father.

PETER DENIES CHRIST 3 TIMES

- Peter and John follow Jesus after His arrest.
- John is let into the High Priest's court.
- Peter is asked 3 times if he is one of Jesus' disciples.

JESUS BEFORE PILATE

- The Jewish leaders are hypocrites.
- The Jewish leaders are eclipsers.
- Pilate sends Jesus to Herod.
- Herod sends Jesus back to Pilate.
- Jesus explains His Kingdom.
- Pilate asks, "What is Truth?"

JESUS' TRIALS

- 1. Annas' Courtyard, Father-in-Law of High Priest
- 2. Caiaphas, the High Priest
- 3. The Sanhedrin, the Jewish Court
- 4. Pontius Pilate, the Roman Governor
- 5. Herod—Jesus under his jurisdiction
- 6. Pontius Pilate
