## Snapshots of the Apostle John from the Divine Photo Album



- 1. He was apparently the <u>youngest</u>, but surely the <u>closest</u> to Jesus of the 12. [John 13:1, 21-25; 19:25-27]
  - At the <u>Passover</u> Table NOT seated at a long banquet table a la Leonardo da Vinci, but reclining on cushions or couches at a low table
  - ➤ At the <u>Bosom</u> of Jesus John was located next to Jesus
  - At the <u>Foot</u> of the Cross James Tissot The View from the Cross. Although the disciples fled when Jesus was arrested; and Peter followed afar off and then was in the courtyard warming himself, and there denied Jesus 3 times, then went out and wept bitterly; John was at the cross and Jesus committed His mother's care to John.

The disciple whom Jesus loved.

**△ A LIFE LESSON**: Strive to be <u>as close to Jesus</u> as you can possibly be on this side of Glory.

Can you be closer to Him than you now are?



- 2. He was originally a disciple of <u>John the Baptist</u>, but was drawn to the <u>Lamb of God</u>. [John 1:35-40]
  - ➤ The <u>No-nonsense</u> Wilderness Preacher The divinely-prophesied Forerunner; "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand;" when many Pharisees & Sadducees came, he said, "You brood of vipers..."

- ➤ The <u>Announcement</u> of the Lamb of God When he saw Jesus coming, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." Two days in a row...
- ➤ The Immediate <u>Transfer</u> of <u>Loyalties</u> Andrew and John followed Jesus; stayed with Him for the day; found and brought their own brothers

**○ A LIFE LESSON:** <u>Change</u> is one of the most difficult things that we have to deal with in life, but <u>when God is in it</u>, it <u>will be for our good</u>.



- 3. A <u>doting</u> mother and the desire to be the <u>greatest</u> in the kingdom. [Mk 9:33-37; Mt 20:20-28; Lk 22:24]
  - ➤ The <u>Frequency</u> of This Discussion Not just once, or even twice! Even at the final Passover table.
  - The Foolishness of This Discussion It revealed their pride and self-seeking.
  - ➤ The Focus of <u>True Greatness</u>. Humbly serving others.
  - **Beware** of seeking something that will not <u>endear</u> us to others nor tend to God's glory.



- 4. The <u>"sons of thunder"</u> and the <u>sin</u> that lurks under the surface. [Lk 9:49-56; Gal 4:18]
  - **Zeal** running out of control. James and John were not pleased with the Samaritans.
  - Zapping was their solution. An extreme solution to be done with them once and for all. [You don't know what manner of spirit you are of!]
  - ➤ Zeal harnessed to the <u>truth</u>. Paul is a supreme example.

## ⊇ Even the most shy among us have a spirit that may flare up on occasion. Free yourself of this tendency with the Spirit's help.

Your spirit needs to be submitted to God's Spirit!



5. The <u>innermost circle</u> of the disciples and the recognition of their <u>important role</u> in the church.

[Mk 5:37; 9:2; 14:33; Gal 2:9]

- > Eyewitnesses of amazing things.
  - → House of <u>Jairus</u> Witnessing the raising of his 12 y/o daughter
  - **→ Mount of** Transfiguration Seeing the majesty of Jesus in His future glory.
  - **○** Garden of <u>Gethsemane</u> Through sleepy eyes seeing the extreme agony of Jesus and hearing His complete submission to the Father
- Exemplary <u>leadership</u> recognized.
  Who seemed to be <u>pillars</u>... Important supporting roles.
  [NOTE: This is a different James.]
- **○** Even if you have a privileged part of the ministry, the most important thing you can do is <u>support the work of the church</u>.



6. The two close friends who were <u>different</u> but the <u>same</u>. [Jn 21:15-19]

A breakfast on the beach prepared by the risen Jesus.

- Peter's public <u>reinstatement</u>. Do you love me more...? Feed My sheep.
- > Peter's predicted <u>death</u>. Foretelling how Peter would die.
- ➤ Peter's probing <u>inquiry</u>. What about my friend John?

Peter's personal <u>focus</u>. NYB! You follow Me! That'll keep you busy

Following Jesus faithfully and diligently is one of the most important things you will ever do. This is a full-time job!



- 7. A man of <u>ripe old age</u> is overwhelmed when he sees an <u>old Friend</u>. [Rev 1:9-18]
  - ➤ The <u>intimate</u> disciple of Jesus. disciple whom Jesus loved
  - ➤ The interim of <u>65</u> years. Crucifixion 30 AD

    Revelation written 95 AD
  - The immediate <u>fall at His feet</u>. A breath-taking symbolic description of the glorified Jesus. Falling in reverential fear and absolute worship.
  - **○** Oh for the day when we too will <u>fall at the feet of Jesus</u>. Until then...
