

Righteous (Rom. 1:17)




2 Tim 2:3-6

- Pursue righteousness,
 faith, love and peace
- Reject foolish and ignorant disputes

- Must not be quarrelsome
- Kind to everyone
- Able to teach
- Patiently enduring evil
- Correcting opponents with gentleness



The Role of God

- Grant them repentance
- Lead to a knowledge of the truth
- Provide escape from snare
