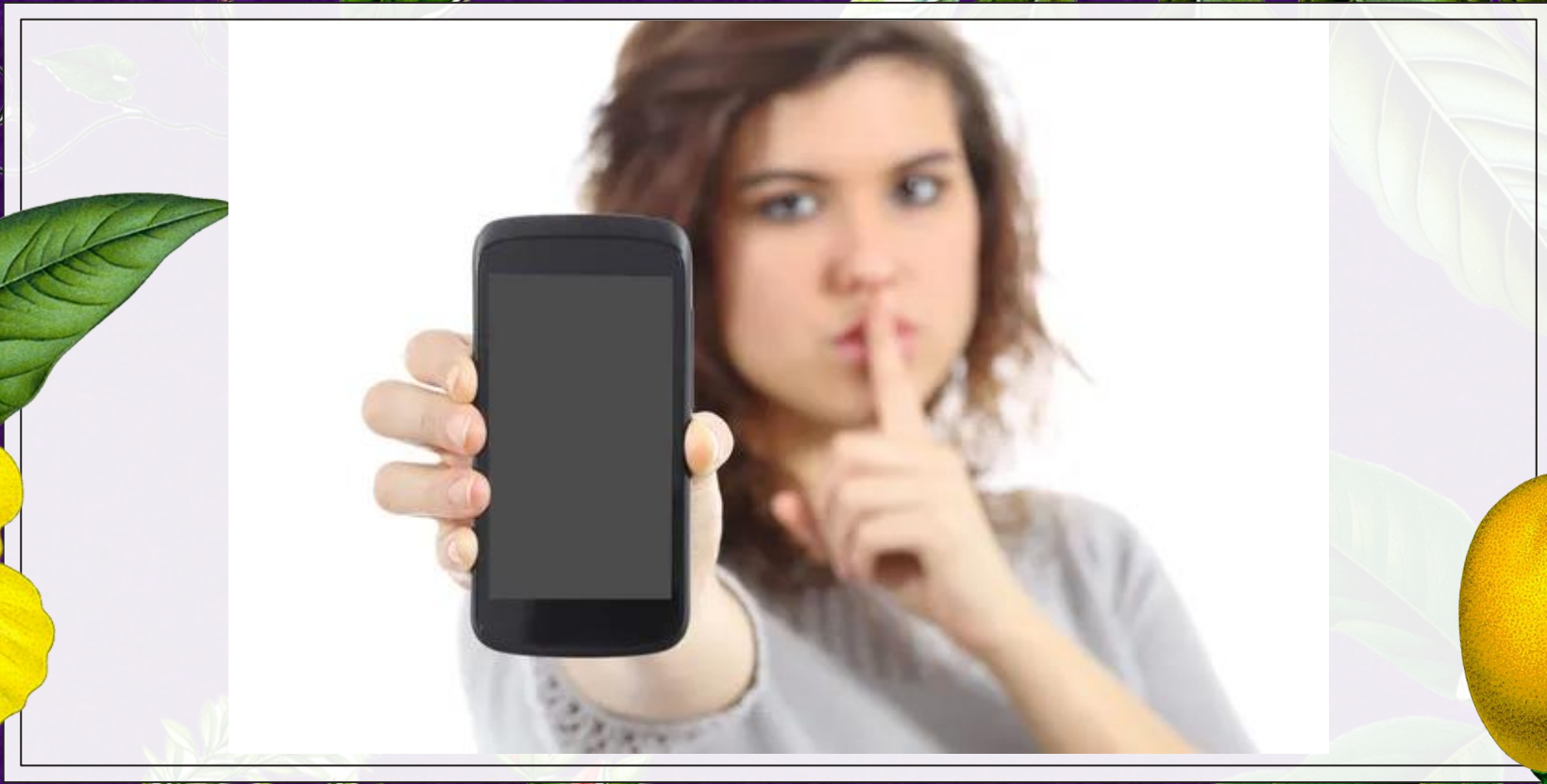
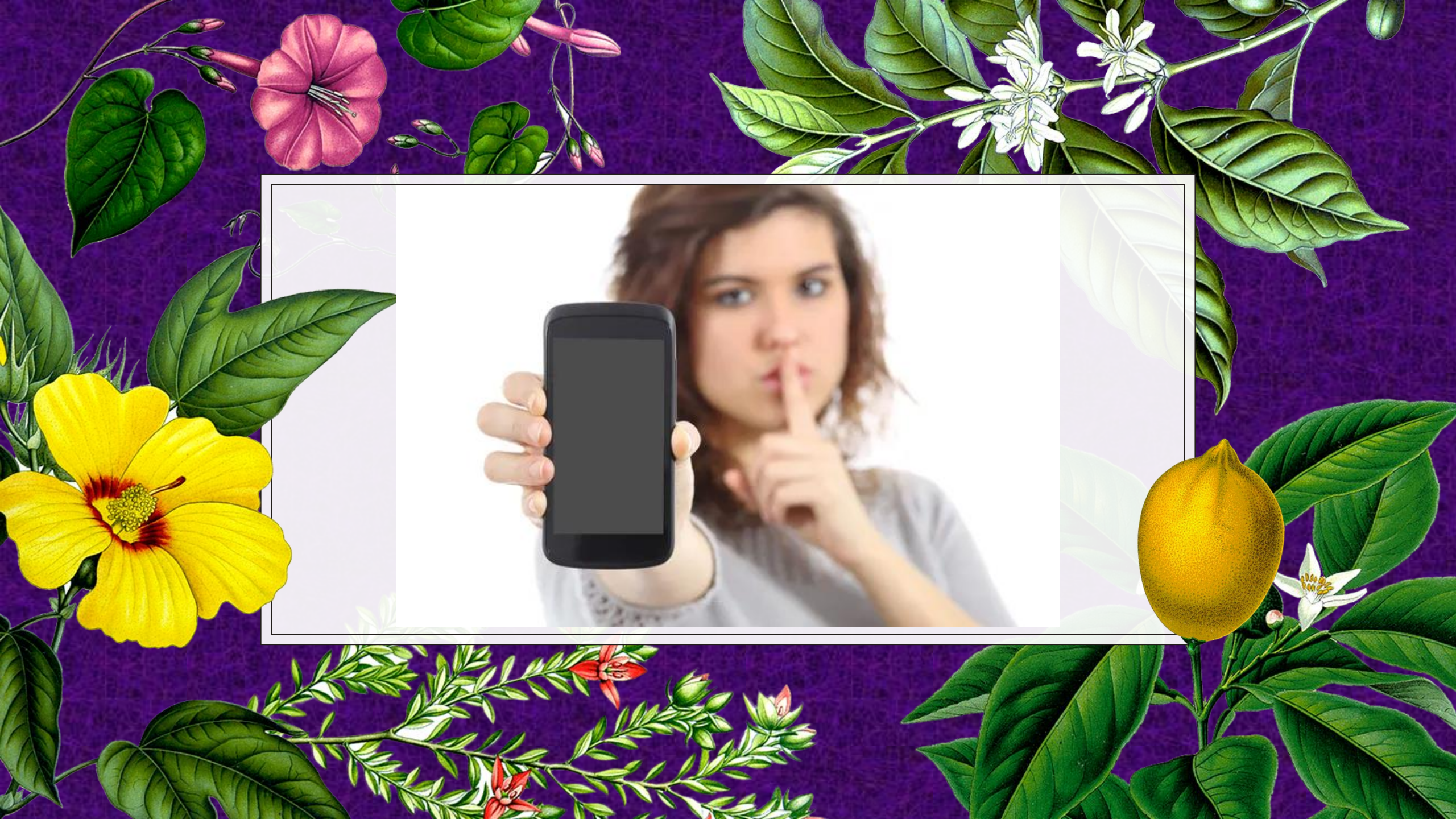

The Fall of Jericho

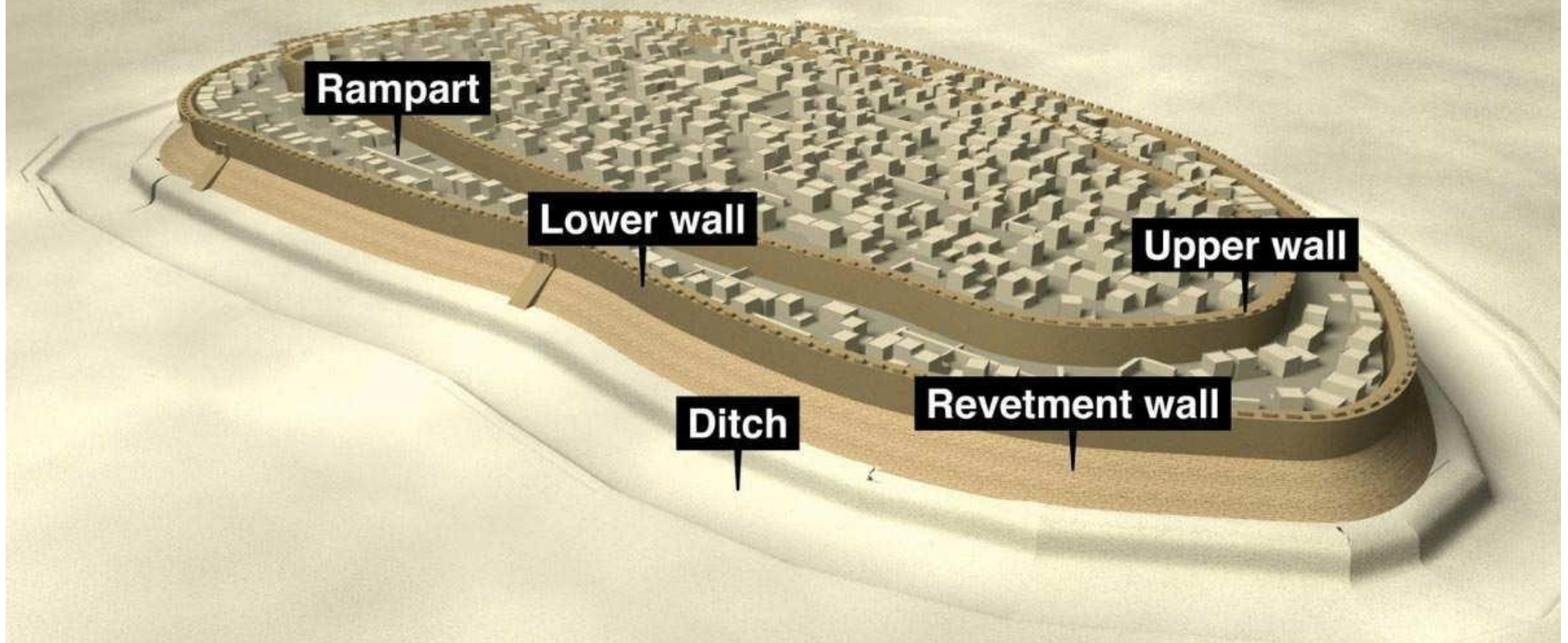


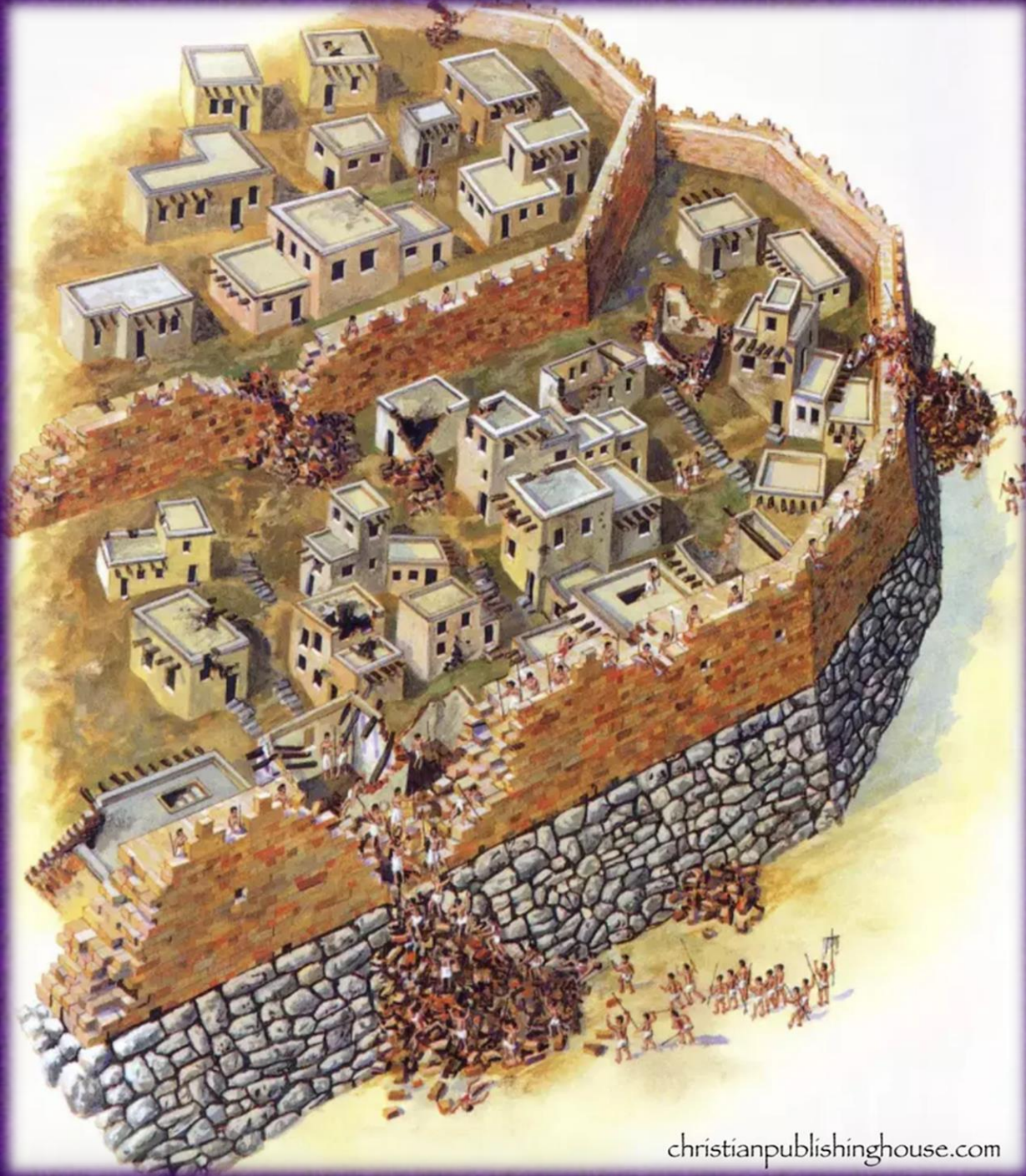

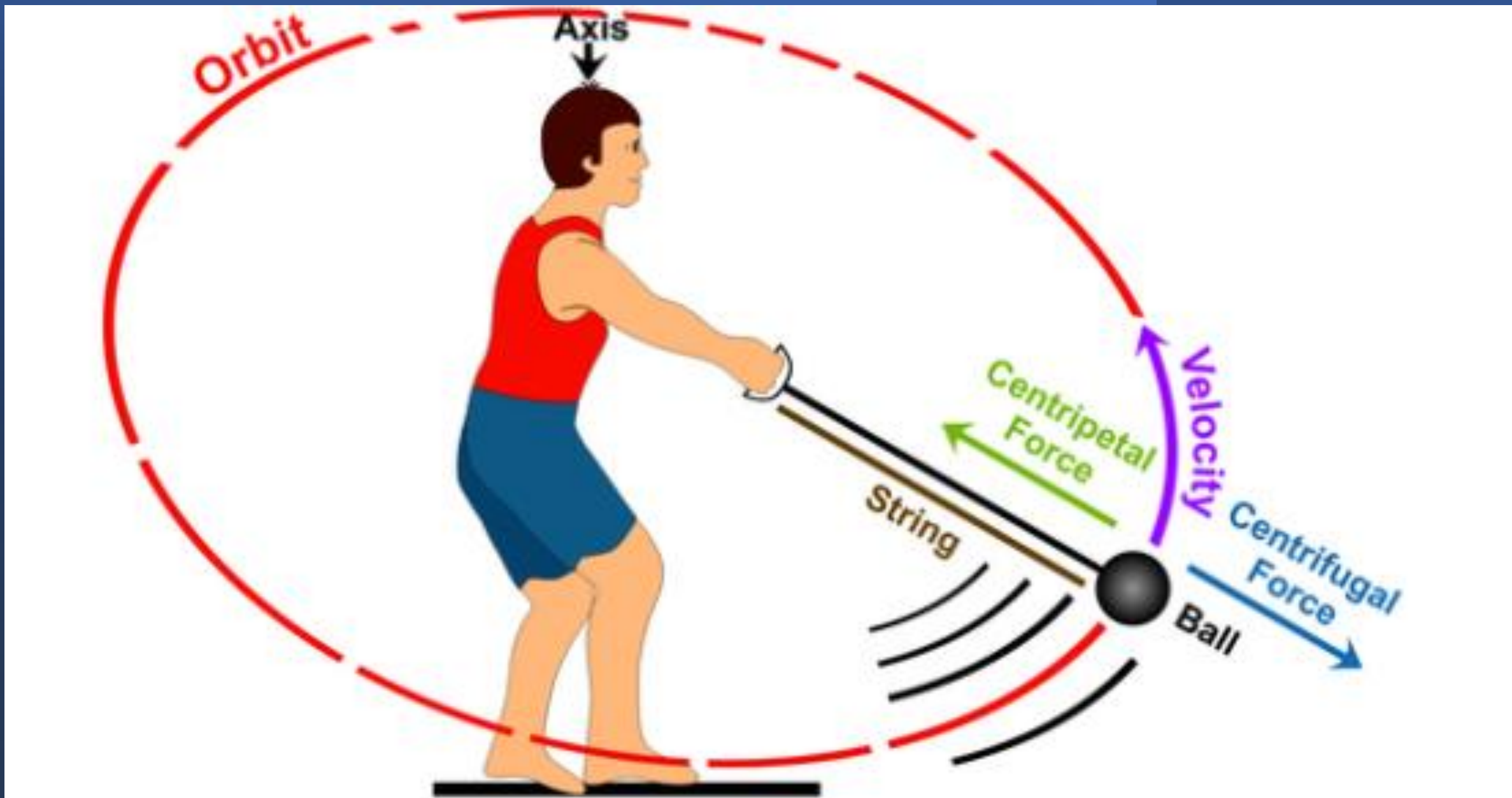


# Ancient Jericho

# Homonyms

Two words that sound the same  
but are spelled differently

# Lessons:

1. God blesses obedience. Don't improvise; don't compromise; instead, prioritize God's word.
  - “Be strong & courageous. Be careful to obey all the law Moses gave you. Do not turn from it to the right or to the left that you may prosper wherever you go” (Joshua 1:7).

# Lessons:

2. God is just & merciful. The cross shows God unleashing grace and justice through Christ.

- “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through Him (Romans 5:8-9).

# Lessons:

3. When we don't understand, we can ask God *why*.

Walk toward God.

Have open hands.

Yield to His sovereignty.

- “For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. As the heavens are higher than the Earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts” (Isaiah 55:8-9).

# Lessons:

4. Share the gospel with a penny.

- “For God so loved the world that He SENT His only Son so that whoever believes in Him will not perish, but will have eternal life” (John 3:16).
