- Revelation 8:7, 11:19 and 16:21—God's judgment involves hail and hailstones.

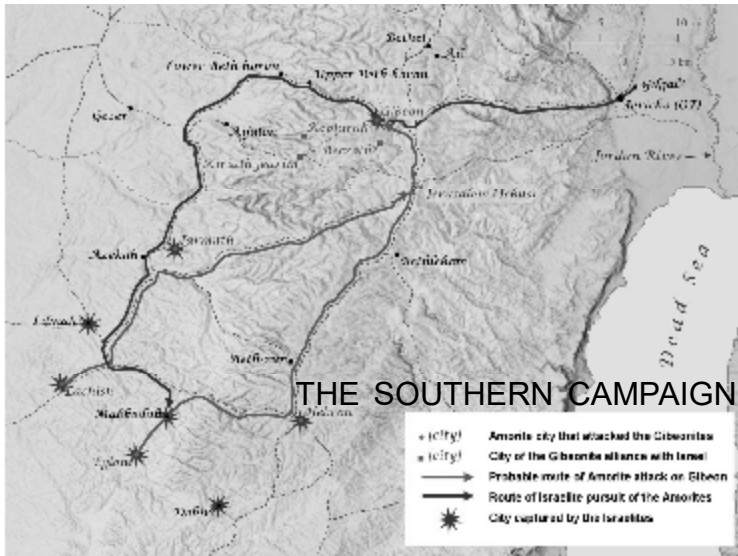


## Sun & Moon Stand Still

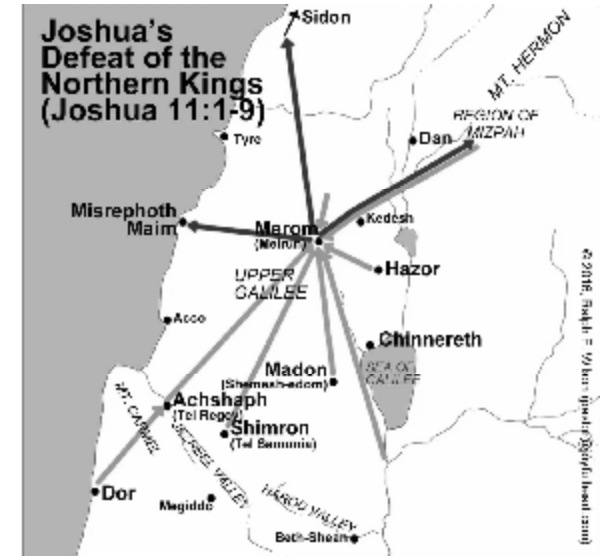
- *AMAD*= to stand, remain, endure, take one's stand, establish
