
REVIEW OF JOSHUA 1-9

- Revelation 8:7, 11:19 and 16:21—God's judgment involves hail and hailstones.






Sun & Moon Stand Still


 AMAD= to stand, remain, endure, take one's stand, establish


POSSIBLE EXPLANATIONS:
